You're a Grown-up Now Charlie Brown Spring 2008

You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown is a musical comedy based on the characters created by cartoonist Charles M. Schulz in his comic strip Peanuts.

You're a Good Man Charlie Brown first premiered off-Broadway on March 7, 1967. The original cast starred Gary Burghoff (Radar in *M*A*S*H*) as Charlie Brown. The show began as a record album with songs written by Clark Gesner based on the Peanuts characters. It ran for 1,597 performances. On February 4, 1999 a revival opened on Broadway.

The revival cast included Kristen Chenoweth (original Glinda in *Wicked*) as Sally (for which she won a Tony Award) and B.D. Wong (*Law & Order: SVU*) as Linus.

Unlike the Broadway version, our story begins with the introduction of a new character, Miss Potts. Miss Potts explains that 35 years ago her 6th grade class performed You're A Good Man Charlie Brown and now the cast has returned to the stage for an encore performance 35 years in the making. Can the cast, now adults, pull it off? We will have to wait and see what transpires in this unique version of You're A Grown-up Now Charlie Brown.
